Mr. Dubuisson,

I have received the e-mail below from my contact at Public Works and Government Services. As indicated in the e-mail string below the Standards Council of Canada (SCC) will now be operating the OSI Registration Authority for Canada. As you may know, the SCC appointed Public Works and Government Services (PWGSC) to undertake this activity a number of years ago. At the request of PWGSC last year, the contract with SCC was dissolved March 31, 2012, due to shift in priorities and lack of resources to maintain this activity at PWGSC. As a result, the SCC took back the role of Canadian Open System Interconnection Registration Authority (COSIRA) effective April 1, 2012. SCC will now be operating the Registration Authority for the OID country arc {joint-iso-itu-t(2) country(16) ca(124) }.
